LITERARY RESPONSE: ONE-PAGER

A one pager is a way of responding to a piece of writing on a single sheet of paper. It represents your own graphic and written interpretation of what you have read. It may be very literal (just based on the facts of the piece) or it may be a symbolic representation of the piece. It helps you visualize what you are reading.

GUIDELINES:

- Use standard-size, unlined paper.
- Fill up the entire page.
- Must be in ink or typed. No pencil.
- Include title and author.
- Colored pencil or markers unless the piece demands black or white.

ELEMENTS:

- Must have two or more excerpts or quotes from the reading (passages that you like or think are important)
- Must have a graphic representation (drawing, magazine picture, or computer graphic that ties in to the piece you read and the quotes you chose.
- Must include a personal response to what you have read (comment, interpretation, evaluation, etc). 5 sentences minimum.
